WHEREAS, students are required to take a minimum of five (5) semester units to be eligible for service on the American River College Student Senate or Club and Events Board;

WHEREAS, some students' face barriers to enrolling in five (5) semester units which include, but are not limited to, financial means, and physical or mental disability;

WHEREAS, the student senate should strive to find simple and cost effective methods of creating community within the student body, and to allow all those within the student body an opportunity to represent themselves and their peers;

WHEREAS, according to the American River College Associated Student Body Constitution "it is the mission of the American River College Associated Student Body Senate to provide the students of the College with a voice in the College's and the Los Rios Community College District's shared governance process."



Senate Resolution

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Student Senate and Club and Events Board shall provide three (3) positions on each board for students who do not meet the unit requirement to serve on the board as full members;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, each non-voting member must be enrolled in at least .5 units at American River College;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the three (3) positions on each board shall be non-voting members;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the three non-voting member positions shall be reserved only for students who do not meet the unit requirements with one (1) position on each board reserved specifically for a disabled student as verified by the office of Disabled Students Programs and Services;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the non-voting members shall meet and maintain the minimum standards of scholarship pursuant to Education Code § 76061;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the American River College Associated Student Body Constitutional Amendments Committee be responsible for inserting the aforementioned changes into the next constitutional draft.
